2. UNIDEST has been under constant observation and investigation by CIC in this area since 1945. This investigation, as well as TIB's former penetration of the levist repatriation Rissian formerly stationed at ANDECH (ASO/TOE), has produced a mass of information and "misinformation" on JUNICOT, his past, and his resent activities. The present report was written in an effort to consolidate, numerize, and analyze all this information, as well as to add such new information as was obtained during 1949.
