4. REPORT OF FINDINGS

40 (AGENCY) On 13 November 1958, the files of FBI, New York, New York, were consulted concerning Victor Jeremy Jerome, aka V. J. Jerome, the father of one of SUBJECT'S associates, and the following information was extracted from FBI report dated 20 August 1958, Bureau File 100-64108:

Jerome resides at 320 Second Avenue, New York City, as a self employed writer from his residence. He was observed at Communist Party Headquarters in New York City on various dates in late 1957 and early 1958. He attended New York State Communist Party Committee meeting on 11 January 1958, was appointed to a Sub-committee to work with the National Commission for Jewish Work, Communist Party, USA, attended the 28th and 29th June 1958 meeting of Communist Party National Committee and was speaker at the faculty of Social Science on 19 January 1958. As of 4 November 1957 he was a subscriber te <u>Mainstream</u> and <u>Political Affairs</u>. Jerome sent New Year greetings to Irving Potash, who was convicted of conspiracy to violate the Smith Act in 1949, was voluntarily deported to Poland in 1955, and was arrested by FBI, New York in January 1957 for illegally entering the United States. In January 1958, Jerome attended a birthday party for Charles Gerber who is said to have identified himself as Press Director of the Upper East Side Section of the Communist Party.

Victor Jeremy Jerome was one of the Communist Party leaders convicted in the United States District Court, Southern District of New York, on 21 January 1953, for violation of the Smith Act of 1940. He was released from Federal Penitentiary, Lewisburg, Pennsylvania, on 17 May 1957, in a conditional release to 28 June 1957 when he completed his sentence for the violation.
