SUBJECT: Briefing of Victor D. BALSAMELLO (P) Regarding Project ALWIDE

- 1. On 8 October accompanied by George Powell, Central Cover Staff, Covert Tax Unit, we met with Victor D. BALSAM-ELLO (P) at the Holiday Inn in Rosslyn for the purpose of briefing him regarding his tax and cover status. Upon arrival we discovered he was just being shown his contract by the case officer and a representative of WH Personnel. After a cursory review of his contract, BALSAMELLO (P) stated that he refused to commit himself for a period of more than one year insmuch as this was a losing proposition for him financially. After a brief discussion, it was agreed that the contract could be amended to cover a period of thirteen months under which he still maintains the same benefits which were set forth in the original agreement. He then voiced objections to the use of his assigned pseudonym and gave the general impression or relunctance to become associated under any terms of agreement.
- 2. He odvised that he had been invited to Florida in August and had a resulting medical problem consisting of fungus which developed on this trip. He stated that at noon on 9 October, he was to receive the results of tests run by two independent doctors whom he had consulted and therefore was in no position to morally commit himself to this contract under any terms. Fortunately Powell and I were introduced in alias and at this point we departed from the meeting.
- 3. We later learned that the subject had been given the true name of the ANNIN proprietary during the above-mentioned visit in Florida. AM WIDE

- 1. FOLLOWING JOHN THOMAS DUNCAN'S ARRIVAL HQS. AND AFTER PRELIMINARY CONTRACT SESSION WITH HQS OFFICERS. HE DECLINED OFFER FOR AMWIDE EMPLOY.
- 2. DUNCAN'S DECISION OSTENSIBLY BASED ON HIS BELIEF HE UNABLE LIVE COFFORTABLY IN TROPICAL CLIME DUE TO IRRITATING SKIN FUNGUS HE CONTRACTED DURING HIS VISIT JMCOBRA. HQS OFFICERS CONCLUDED, HOWEVER, 1 RESULT HIS VISITS SEVERAL UNIVERSITIES DURING OVERLAND DRIVE TO WASHINGTON, AND THAT HE NOW PLANNING RETURN TO ACADEMIC STUDIES. DUNCAN ALSO HAD SOME RESERVATIONS CONCERNING PERSONA RESTRICTIONS RESULTING FROM WOFIRM EMPLOY, AND PREFERRED DISQUALIFY SELF NOW RATHER THAN PROCEED JMCOBRA AREA.
- 3. RELATIONS WITH DUNCAN APPEAR AMICABLE AND HE ASSURED HQS OFFICER HIS AWRENESS THAT ALL PREVIOUS CONVERSATIONS AND

SUBJECT: Meeting with John Thomas Duncan: Project AMWIDE Candidate (1145 - 1515 hours, 8 October 1968; Reselyn, Virginia)

63

- 1. Donald Winters and I met briefly with "Tom" Duncan in the lobby of the Holiday Inn, Rosslyn, Virginia, after which Duncan and I had lunch at the Orleans House. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss any problem areas or questions which Duncan may have had incident to his coming "on board." Further, I was to remain with Duncan until such time as he would be introduced to John Martin that afternoon. (NOTE: The latter session was arranged for the purpose of having Duncan eign the contract which had been prepared for him, and to explain his cover arrangement and other pertinent administrative details.)
- 2. During the earlier discussion, (Vinters) Duncan and I chatted for nearly thirty minutes; though Duncan mentioned (1) the skin fungus which he had contracted during an earlier visit to Florida; and (2) his desire to confer by telephone with his dectors concerning the results of recent skin tests, Duncan did not give any indication that he intended to refuse the position for which he had been selected. Having still another appointment, (Vinters) excused himself at about 1230 hours and told Duncan that he hoped they might have an opportunity to get together prior to Duncan's departure.
- 3. Subsequently, Duncan and I lunched together, during which time the conversation turned to Duncan's recent travels and his several visits to university campuses while enroute to Washington. He mentioned that he had found the doctoral program at the University of Minnesota particularly attractive. He did not say that he intended to enroll at that institution, but he several times alluded to "picking up the doctorate" at some future date. With reference to the aforementioned AMWIDE position, Duncan stated that he could not do may-thing -- (While in the Agency's employ) -- which might run counter to his

'principles''or set of values. I assured him that it was extremely unlikely that he would experience any difficulty in that regard, and I recalled at that time how casual he seemed throughout our brief discussion of his forthcoming affiliation with the Agency. In retrospect, it seems quite clear that Duncan was not really interested in being reassured; his decision to refuce the Agency's offer of employment had likely been reached days before.

- 4. During the course of the afternoon meeting with Martin, and later with George Powell and Richard Biladeau, it was my impression that neither the terms of the contract nor the assignment of a pseudonym was of paramount concern. Rather, Duncan's expressed misgivings were only superficial excuses for backing out of a relationship which he had come to view as untenable. Doubtless, his skin condition was a factor, however, had Duncan been sufficiently enthusiastic about joining the AMWIDE project, it is my feeling that he would have done so despite his malady. (NOTE: The doctors reportedly told Duncan that many people living in Florida had the same problem, and that Duncan "could live with it.")
- 5. In sum, it is my opinion that Duncan was unwilling to accept the job regardless of the terms which he might be able to exact, e.g., thirteen months as opposed to two-years, etc. It is conceivable that had it not been for Duncan's desire to vicit relatives in the Washington, D.C., area, he may not have presented himself at all. Why Duncan agreed to meet with (Martin), Powell and Biladeau remains something of a mystery to me. He may have felt some obligation to (Winters) for whom he expressed high regard, or he may have done so simply out of curiosity.
- 6. Security Implications: Known to Duncan are the true name and address of AMWIDE's production facility, and the true name of Cedric D. BARTILUCCI. Though it is not believed that Duncan will cause this information to become known. Station JMCOBRA has been alerted to the possibility.

L'The Il June 1971 issue of the Washington Post carried the obituary for Arnoldo M O N D A D O R I, Italy's number one publisher who retired two years previously leaving the publishing house in the hands of his son Giorgio. Yearly sales were said to average \$120 million dollars. On the above mentioned trip to Zurich, H E I M was involved in smuggling a large trunk (contents unknown) through customs in Torino, Italy by bribing the officials. HEIM purchased a King Air Beechcraft in May 1966 valued at approximately \$500,000, which was registered to him for tax purposes but owned by two wealthy Italians. HEIM's U.S. business address in 1968 was Paul K. HEIM, Aviation Consultant, Hays Street, Gettysburg, Pa. 17325. The foregoing was based on LNERGO reports.

He has been a technical advisor to many Cuban exile groups concerning plans to infiltrate and launch missions against Cuba. Was involved with Rolando MASFERRERROjac, et al, in planned a invasion of Haiti in 1966. The participants were akrested by LNYAPA officials, but DEMPSEY evaded apprehension. In March 1969

he was arrested and incarcerated in Monroe County Jail, Key West, Florida, along with eleven other persons, in connection with an accident at a secret military camp discovered in the Florida Everglades, allegedly being used by Haitian exiles preparing to invade Haiti. Doe MPSEY was the commander in charge of operations and training. DEMPSEY and the other camp commander, Edmund KOLBY, were in charge of disbursements. In June 1969 DEMPSEY participated in a bombing mission at Port-Au-Prince, Haiti, was deported from the Bahamas to Miami and arrested there by LNYAPA agents. He later was returned to Canada but was not prosecuted. In September 1969 DEMPSEY advised an LNERGO informant that he still resided in Canada and was associated with an American (not further identified) who was then writing a book about the assassination of President Kennedy.

## **OPERATIONS CONTACT REPORT**

SUBJECT: Meeting with IDEN and Wife

DATE AND PLACE: 23 July 1968, 1000 - 2000 Hours, Albuquerque,

New Mexico

- 1. Clyde B. MEGENNITY first met IDEN alone during the morning of 23 July; the meeting was held in MEGENNITY's lottel room. MEGENNITY introduced himself as a representative of LNHARP, indicating to IDEN that he was involved in work of a confidential nature for LNHARP. IDEN was then given the broad outline of the AMWIDE job. This included location in the JMCOBRA area, work as a producer/script writer, possible travel throughout the Caribbean, and a general calary bracket around \$10,000. IDEN was also teld that LNHARP would pay his transportation and moving costs to the JMCOBRA area.
- 2. IDEN ctated that he had already intended to submit (on 1 August) a thirty day resignation notice from his current job at the University of New Mexico's TV Studio. He indicated that he and his wife planned to go to Europe and approximately six menths studying and travelling. IDEN is interacted in studying broadcasting techniques and operations in Switzerland. He indicated come regret over the possibility of having to cancel these plans, however acknowledged the career job opportunities that the AMWIDE offer would afford him.
- 3. In answering additional questions about the job itself, IDEN was told that he would be working estensibly for a commercial company engaged in the preparation of program materials for the Latin American audience. IDEN was advised that these programs would be of social/economic nature, designed to be progressive and reformist in tone. IDEN seemed most interested in the concept and, according to several remarks he made throughout the day, the nature of the broadcasts fits in quite well with his own political thinking concerning the Latin America area.

- 4. At noon time MEGENNITY met IDEN's wife. She is an intelligent and vivacious person who obviously would be very much interested in, and involved in, anything her husband would be doing. She was given more or less the same cover run down concerning the AMWIDE job. She expressed great interest and asked if there was any role she could do in this venture.
- 5. During the afternoon IDEN and his wife drove MEGENNITY throughout the Albuquerque and Santa Fe area showing him several sights, but also discussing the overall job considerations and ramifications.
- 6. IDEN indicated to MEGENNITY that his Spanish was adequate for handling virtually all situations. He feels completely at ease verbally with the language and indicated he could conduct Spanish interviews and personal reporting jobs for AMWIDE. It did not seem appropriate to test his Spanish capability. His wife has little or no Spanish. Neither IDEN nor his wife has travelled or lived in the eastern United States. The idea of going to the JMCOBRA area obviously is new to them and they approached it with some reservations. MEGENNITY indicated that if a short visit to the JMCOBRA area might satisfy their curiosity, and assist them in making a decision concerning the acceptance of the AMWIDE job, that such a visit could probably be arranged.
- 7. It is MEGENNITY's opinion that both these individuals are highly suited for the AMVIDE job. They are curious intellectually, have a very pragmatic outlook on political matters, are most enthuciastic about things which interest them, and seem like a fine team asset to have at the AMVIDE Facility. MEGENNITY feels, wherever possible, we should make inducements to insure that IDEN and his wife decide favorably in acceptance of the AMVIDE job. MEGENNITY urged them to call him at any time they had questions and considerations and, above all, not to make any final decision (particularly negative) without discussing it with MEGE-NNITY (what MEGENNITY had in mind here, was the flexibility to suggest that they might go to Europe for as long as three months and then return to start at the AMWIDE job around 1 December).
- 8. The experience in visiting the IDENS, both of whom are young, without roots either family or professionally and who are already giving up their current jobs, indicates that the problem of recruiting personnel for AMWIDE is indeed going to be a difficult one. It is MEGENNITY's opinion that from all the other candidates we will hardly find

appear who is moss in a position to take on immediately an AMWIDE position than the IDDNS. All possible exerts circle therefore to make to sign them on brand.


