1. Transmitted herewith are two reports dealing with Espineros SMIRNICHENKI and one report on Colonel KUCHENCHENKI.

2. Headquarters' files contain no additional information on KUCHENCHENKI.

3. The attached reports present the highlights of SMIRNICHENKI's activities which are pertinent to our current interests; however, the following flow of information leads evidence to the supposition that SMIRNICHENKI has had connections with the US: A report dated 4 August 1955 from (an official British Service) states that SMIRNICHENKI, then Charge d'Affaires at the Polish Legation in Tehran, was known to have made a "recruitment" approach while on a trip to Kabul, Afghanistan, in mid-1955.
