We have discussed the aforementioned violation with Miss 03 (Wentworth) the custodian of the documents and Mr. Phillips the WH/4 Staff duty officer, and have pointed out the need for greater vigilance and personal security. Inasmuch as Miss Wentworth and Hr. Phillips have had no previous violations, it is recommended that no further action be taken in this matter.
