MEMORANDUM FOR THE RECORD

SUBJECT: AELADIE/1 Chance Meeting with Petr DERYABIN

1. James R. Harris, SR officer assigned to the AKIADLES has reported that on Saturday, 6 January 1902, he and one of the Security Officers accompanied ARIADLE/1 to Ray's Barber Shop in Vienna, Virginia for a haircut. Upon leaving the barber shop at about 1730 hours, they accidentally met Petr DERYABIN who was walking in the opposite direction. DERYABIN recognized ARIADLE/1 instantly, and the two shook hands and greeted each other enthusiastically. DERYABIN inquired about ARIADLE/1's family, and ARIADLE/1 said that they were well and were with him. AEIADLE/1 asked DERYABIN if he had married, to which DERYABIN replied that he had, and that as of the day before yesterday he was the proud father of a son. DERYABIN presented a cigar to each of the others. DERYABIN asked Mr. [Harris,] "When will all this be in the newspapers?" Mr. [Harris] replied that he didn't know. Mr. [Harris] congratulated DERYABIN on the birth of his son and told him and AELADLE/1 that the street corner was not an appropriate place to talk. The others agreed, and they parted.

2. Mr. Harris reports that during the encounter, no one addressed or referred to anyone by name, hence neither DERYABIN nor AEIADLE/1 are aware of the other's current name or precise whereabouts.
