- 2. Source said that he was a member of the PRE and the FNAC in Habana. When asked what the FOAC is, he said that it is the Federacion y Organizacion Anticommunista Cubana. He explained that the DRE is trying to reorganize and that the FOAC, a large united organization, is trying to help the DRE. The FOAC, he said, is instructing the DRE in its reorganization.
- 3. Source said that his DHE contact is living on Lources y Villoldo, Arroyo Apolo, Habena. He said that Is in direct touch with an Ob FOAC coordinator and that his job is to organize student groups for passive resistence activities. This includes, he said, propagana work, distributing pamphlets and starting rumors.
- h. Source said that the identity of FOAC members is kept quite secret, but he was avare that one lis an 06 FOAC leader in Habana. He knew no other details.
