Possible Contacts with FI Agents

1. Cn 22 April 1/54, the Atlanto, Soldent Agina contestra cae no D. Michtrich, a W monufacturers' representative, who lives the City. We was visiting the Tebi Componition, Columba, Trad Company Courte, which is one of his accounts in Junico. After Vining m the sterdard explanation of Agency interest, Michtrich stated that he should make compatiting clear, ie., that he worked for the Agency in Maxico. To qualified this statement by explaining that his antensive background and experience in linkico enabled him to set up meeting places, "front" offices and other "cover" projects for CIA, I.I and State Department. Although he was quite candid there was no: rincon to doubt that he was telling the truth.

2. Wichtrich felt that these agencies were doing a good job in Champing and reporting the Empired situation and therefore did not that they had everlooked emything in not solding him for his own clinions and Communitions. This raises the question as to whether he is a "legitimate" contact for our exploitation. He talked freshy clout the political cituation and appears to be as knowledgeable as engune we could expect to first. He mentioned, however, that engthing which he reported might be duplication. Hevertheless, some of his views are very interesting. He not only feels that Padilla Hervo (and his executive secretary, Dugene de Annorma), Carrillo Flores, L. o, Coniceros and Cardenes are pro-Communist but that there are Committee indications of a growing trend toward the left by the viole prominet. Two comples of this in his opinion are Ruis's promised provements, such as rooms, about which nothing has been done and tio recent devaluation of the pers. These create insecurity, insuaillity and confusion in the well known pattern of Communist influence and infiltration. Another symptom of instability is the fact that Puben Januaillo, a bandit leader who was formerly associated with Consigues, has successfully defied all attempts by the police to control his activities throughout the states of lindeo and librelos.

3. Concerning the activities of General Henriquez, whose chility to stage a successful revolution is doubtful, Wichtrich

thought we should contact one Test Hin, a former associate of Remigner, who possibly can be becauded in How York through the lumber or physical people. His is suppossely a US citizen who had a thriving lumber business in Runico until he sold out some sixteen months ago when it appeared that Henriquez would be persecuted by the new coverment. Since then he attempted a consecond but recoming sold out again to return to Hew York. What he says is likely to be an exaggeration of true facts, however.

4. Please chrise whether future contents should be made with Whishtrich who will be in Columbus again in July.
