COMMENTS:

1. Mr. PANEQUE was one of six members of the radop trainees who were given brief psychological assessments on 3-13 August 1964. They were given a group battery of ability tests, checked personality questionnaires, and each was interviewed for at least an hour.

The test battery consisted of a series of measures of 2. non-verbal intellectual abilities, involving principally the per-ception of relationships between objects and symbols and the manipulation of numbers and numerical concepts. While this battery has not be used extensively with Cuban groups, experience with it elsewhere suggests its usefulness in predicting adaptability to the intellectual demends of training. On the attached forms, Mr. PANEQUE's neme appears on a scale which shows his performance relative to other Cubans tested to date.

3. Mr. PANEQUE is the oldest. least intelligent, and most experienced member of the radop group. The tests indicate that he has little obility to deal with abstract or symbolic aspects of a problem. Thus, training side will be of little value to him; rether, actual work on the equipment and considerable time for prectice will be necessary to mester the basic skills. He is a rother simple man who, through diroumstonees, moneged to attain a position of command and prestige. His past success appears due more to his outgoing, spressive, and cell-confident manner than to intellectual abilities. Whether he will be willing to assume a subordinate position on a team is doubtful. In fact, it is quite likely that he could and would attempt to dominate and control any term leader who has not had the experiences and positions of leader-ship that he (FANEQUE) has had in the past. Moreover, he seems to be a rather independent individual who might, engage in activities either on his own or in behal of some or anization not sponsored by KUBARK. All-in-cll, his chortegmings tend to outweigh his nscets.
