SUBJECT: Albanians to Leave for Germany; ECIS Use of Three Bulgarian Refugees; ECIS Commentator's Tour for Information Concerning Albania.

1. Forty six Albanians are to leave the Lavrion camp for Germany via American aircraft on 21 July 1961. They will be trained for operations.<sup>29</sup>
2. The [ECIS] has questioned three Bulgarian refugees who were brought from Salonika on 19 July 1961. They are: Spas Todarov [RAITH], Stralzo [MARIANOS], and Stefan Petrov [PETROV]. They will be housed at Lavrion and are to be used operationally by [the British.]<sup>24</sup>
3. Francis [MORL] [RAITH], the ECIS commentator, has recently been in Athens collecting information concerning Albania. He had previously been in Paris to see the French Foreign Office about this matter, as well as having made a visit to Yugoslavia in connection with gathering information about the 6000 Albanian refugees inside Yugoslavia. The Greek authorities did not allow [RAITH] to visit the Lavrion Red Cross camp which is under their control. [RAITH] visited Lavrion on 19 July 1961. The commentator will leave for Rome on 21 July 1961 to continue his study of the Albanian situation.<sup>24</sup>
4. The above information is from [an official Greek source.]<sup>24</sup>
