

Mr. (Scoefield) advised 03 that he will inform Mr. (John Ryan,) Safehouse Branch, X3683, that it Will no longer be necessary for the Branch to inquire re prospective apartments for A-1 in the N.W. section of Washirgton, per WH/SA 64-376 dated 6 May 1964
