





- From a usually reliable, sensitive source, information has been received that a 1963 Oldsmobile, 4 door, grey and blue, carrying New Mexico license plates 6-11488, was parked in front of the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City on 6 November 1967. The license plates had red numbers on a yellow background.
- A man, woman and child were seen leaving the Cuban Embassy and driving away in the Oldsmobile. It was later loarned that the man gave his name as Luis SUAREZ, and he appeared to be Cuban. He was 1.60 meters, weighed about 60 kilos, was about 45 years old, had black heir, aquiline nose, and large face. The wife had dark hair and appeared to be mulatto. The child was about 3 years old. 

WALLACE's father, the late Tom WALLACE, former editor of the LOUISVILLE TIMES and exponent of hemispheric solidarity, blamed the United States for poor Latin American relations. Henry WALLACE is a prolific writer of letters to public opinion columns of Louisville newspapers in support of the CASTRO regime in Cuba and critical of U.S. policy toward Cuba.

- c. DBA-35720, 1 March 1963, reported Subject served in the U.S. Merchant Marine from November 1942 to February 1943 when he was discharged by reason of physical disability.
- d. DBA-38513, 16 April 1963. A U.S. official in Cuba described WALLACE as an excellent writer, an exhibitionist and a very odd person. A correspondent for CHICAGO TRIBUNE believed WALLACE to be a Communist sympathizer or at least to have an affinity for Communists and fellow travelers as exhibited both by his actions and his writings. A TIMES correspondent who was acquainted with WALLACE for years, did not believe him to be a Communist but said he is restless, desires to be exceptional; however, appears to have no dedicated idealism.
- e. DBA-44329, 17 June 1963. WALLACE graduated from the University of Kentucky in 1938. Worked for the Lexington Kentucky newspaper, 1938-40; Puerto Rico WORLD JOURNAL, 1940-41; Federal Communications Commission, Puerto Rico, 1942. Reportedly contributed to the Fair Play for Cuba Committee and received the WORKERS WORLD. WALLACE claimed he refused to permit his wife's cooperation with I&NS as a condition to her receiving citizenship.
- f. DBA-49729, 23 August 1963. An LNERGO source who was previously assigned to the American Embassy, Havana advised that he knew Subject in Cuba 1947-51. In 1949 Subject was requested by the Cuban government to leave due to an article he wrote for LIFE about his carefree life with Cuban girls. Source described Subject's wife as a "beatnik". While the source was not aware of the political beliefs of Subject or his wife, he received a letter in mid-1963 from WALLACE which was very pro-CASTRO. The envelope contained a saying "Ban A-Bomb" or something of this nature.
- g. DBA-98318, 4 February 1965, reported that WALLACE and his family were going to Solland for an extended visit and have reportedly applied for permanent residence in Holland. Mrs. WALLACE became a naturalized U.S. citizen on 30 August 1963. WALLACE contributed to the American Committee for the Protection of Foreign Born in 1963; in 1964 subscribed to PEKING REVIEW, and contributed to the National Committee to Abolish the House Un-American Activities Committee. Set forth in this report were associations with various American CP figures.
- h. ONHA-33396, 23 December 1966. A reliable source reported that Soviet Intourist representative in The Hague, Vladilen Aleksandrovich PRYAKHIN (201-236430) in in contact with Klass de VRIES, Dutch Communist and father of Sonja WALLACE (nee de VRIES). Klass de VRIES, Dutch Communist, has made several trips to the USSR, is a financial supporter of the Communist Party of the Netherlands, and his restaurant is visited by various Iron Curtain diplomats, but also, however, by different Dutch Government officials.

- 1. A reliable source reported that on 30 January 1967 a man and a woman driving a vehicle with Kentucky license plates 763-944 visited the Cuban Embassy in Bexico City. They left the Embassy carrying a bulky package. The windshield of their car carried a sign saying "Fuera de Vietnam." A set of photos showing the man and the woman are provided your Sureau for identification. This Office would appreciate being informed if either of the two individuals in the photos are positively identified.
- 2. Investigation revealed that Kentucky license plates 763-944 were not issued in 1965. On 23 February 1966 these plates were issued to David William PHILLIPS, 4166 Franks Court, Harrodsburg, Kentucky. PHILLEPS's Kentucky driver's license shows that he was born on 26 June 1920 in Mercer County. As of 1963 he was a city policeman and had no derogatory police record. The files of this Office show no record of PHILLIPS.
- 3. On 7 January 1967 the same license number was issued to Henry French WALLACE 7801 Rose Island Road, Prospect, Kentucky. WALLACE's driver's license shows that he was born 12 June 1915 in Louisville, Kentucky. He lists his occupation as farmer, and has no police record. Our Office traces on WALLACE follow:

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B. The visitor to the Cuban Embassy could possibly be Henry French WALLACE, Journalist, who is well known to your Bureau as a former resident of Cuba and as outspoken critic of U.S. policy on Cuba.

b. He is married to Sonja de VRIES, who, according to a usually reliable source, was in 1953, a member of the Dutch Youth Party and on an unspecified date was to have attended the Youth Congress in Prague.

- 1. A usually reliable source reported that on 5 December 1966 a Ford Mustang bearing Texas license plate CTF-730 was even at the Cuban Embassy in Nexico City. The occupants of the car came to pick up Remiro Jesus ARNEU-Quintana and Reymaldo CEPZDA-Bermandez, two Cuban Embassy CUIS Officials.
- 2. The source has identified the occupants of this vehicle as being identical with those who in the past have come in two different vehicles bearing Mexican plates. One of the vehicles has been identified as a 1963 Ford stationwagen with plates TTT-AF, which was issued to Moises FORCE-Cortes of Cabanas 62. Our Mexico City Office is still swalting the identification of the owner of the other vehicle used, which was a blue Volkowagen with Mexico plates 669-SM. These two vehicles have been used in visits to the Cuban Embassy on 3 June and 9, 23, 24, and 28 Movember 1966 when AEREU and CEPEDA have been contacted.
- 3. Investigation revealed that the Texas plate was assigned to a 1966 Ford Mustang owned by Dr. J. N. GONZALES of 318 Saunders, San Antonio, Texas.
- 4. Credit and police checks were negative. The San Antonio telephone directory was checked and the results were also negative. A Credit Bureau source checked the City Directory and stated that there was no such address as 318 Saundars—the street begins in the 1100 block.
- 5. There was no identifiable information on Dr. CONZALES in the files of this Office, and was no information on Maises FOECE-Cortes in either our Mexico City files or in the files of this Office.
