Dear Mr. Mastrocolat

The United States Covernment, as represented by the Contracting Officer, hereby contracts with you as an independent contractor for the submission of certain information and related services of a confidential nature under the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Compensation. In full consideration for the submission of such information and services you will be paid a fee of \$50 for any day or fraction thereof during which you are utilized under this agreement, not to exceed \$265 per week. Payments will be made as directed by you in writing in a manner acceptable to the Government. No taxes will be withheld therefrom, but it will be your responsibility to report such income under existing Federal income tax laws and regulations. An appropriate Form 1079 will be furnished by the Government-in furtherance of its tax reporting requirement.
- 2. Travel. You will be advanced or reimbursed funds for necessary empires incurred in connection with such operational travel as may be directed or authorized by the Government. This may include per diem in lieu of subsistence in the course of such travel and while on temporal other entry from your domestic permanent post of assignment. Payment and accounting for such expenses will be in substantial conformance with applicable Government regulations.
- 3. Operational Expenses. You will be advanced or reinibursed funde for necessary operational expenses including, but not limited to, entertainement and the parchage of information, as specifically approved by the Covernment. Such funds will be subject to accounting in substantial compliance with Covernment regulations.
- 4. Execution of Deciments. If, in the performance of corrieous under this contract, you assume the custody of Covermont funds or take title of second to properly of any nature whatecover and wherever vituate, which property has in fact been purchased with monies of the U.S. Covernment, you hereby recognize and acknowledge the existence of a trust relationship, either cupsess or constructive, and you agree to execute whatever documents may be required by the Covernment to evidence this relationship.
- 5. Status. You are not an employed of the United States Coverns ont under this agreement and are not extitled to any benefits normally included to an employee status.
- 5. Socracy. You will be required to keep forever secret this contract and all information which you may obtain by reason hereof (unless released in writing by the Covernment from such obligation), with full knowledge that visinities of such secrecy may subject you to estiminal presecution under the Replanage Laws, dated 25 June 1948, as amended, and other applicable laws and regulations.

- 9. Instructions. Instructions received by you from the Covernment in brising or otherwise are a part of this contract and are incorporated herein, provided that such instructions are not inconsistent with the forms hereof.
- 8. Unauthorized Commitments. No promises or commitments pertaining to rights, privileges or beastles other than those expressly elipulated in writing in this agreement or any amendment thereto shall be binding on the Government.
- . 9. Torm. This contract is effective as of 5 June 1959, and shall continue thereafter for a period of one (1) year unless sooner terminated either:
 - (a) By thirty (30) days' actual notice by either party hereto, or
 - (b) Without prior notice by the Covernment, in the event of a breach of this contract by your violation of the security provisions hereof or by your otherwise rendering yourself unavailable for acceptable service.

Subject to the availability of appropriations, this agreement may be extended upon notice from the Government. Termination of this agreement will not release you from the obligations of any occurity eath you may be required to take.
