Subject is a serious mental case and the individual who continues to be treated by a private psychlatrist; Dr. Miguel A. Mora. The cost of treatment by Dr. Mora is paid by JMWAVE and at \$25.00 per office visit the monthly expense averages \$225.00. There have been no recent charges for drugs. Subject receives a monthly payment of \$225.00 from JMWAVE and has successfully resisted previous efforts to disassociate him from Dr. Mora.

Subject is a Garcia Lines case who suffers from advanced glaucoma and is nearly blind. He continues to receive periodic out-patient care at Jackson Memorial Hospital for which JMWAVE pays the cost of treatment and drugs. Subsequent to the last surgery on 13 September 1965 for removal of cataracts, there have been ten charges for treatment and/or drugs which total \$95.00. Of this amount \$62.00 was for seven items in 1966.
