On receipt of the attached I checked Mr. Houston who said that he thought we might be able to help INS but this would depend on 1) what subject's status is now and 2) what INS actually wanted. 03, 03

On 5/16/60 I checked with (Eisenman & Mc'Clain) of W & D. The latter later replied that they had arranged for subject's IMARC use to be headquarters only - rather than involving TDY under (commercial cover) 24

In 5/16/60, I told Mr. Papich we were checking on this - before I went any further, Mr. Papich stated he had already told INS subject is not available for testifying.

I recontacted (Mc'Clain) ⁰³ and it was agreed that it would be best to let their arrangements stand, i.e. use him in DC only.
