The following comments are in answer to paragraphs 1, 3, 6 and 7 of referenced memorandum (paragraphs 2, 4 and 5 are to be answered by other components in the Agency):

a. Concerning paragraph 1, the initials which appear on papers in the AMLASH file, identified as "G.N.N." by the SSC, are believed to be "G.W.R.", those of Grace W.

b. The only information in the Latin America Division concerning Gilberto Lopez mentioned in paragraph 3 is a report that confirms his travel to Cuba on 27 November 1963. This travel information is already reflected in Lopez<sup>+</sup> 201 file.

29 c. The cryptonym mentioned in paragraph 6 refers to the liaison program our Station in Mexico City maintains with the Mexican Security Service.

d. The Mannells referred to in paragraph 7 are not located in the Washington area. They could be made available to the SSC, however, given a reasonable time frame of at least two or three days notice.
