There is enclosed for the Bureau a copy of the. 3 Bmodilisd latest article in the series by THOMAS GITTINGS BUCHABAN, JR.s which appeared in "L'Express" on 3-26-64.

In this article BUCHAMAN discusses the people "in power" in Dallas and states that they used gangstors as firont men" in assisting and protecting OSwald in that city. Without their concurrence, according to BUGHAMAH, OSWALD would never have been able to have obtained employment in Dallas. BUCHANAM describes the members of the Dalla. Council as being the wealthy and influential people behind the scenes in that community and states that seven members of the Council represent the "cream" of the influential citizens of Dallas. In the latter group he mentions H. L. HUNT, his son LAMAR HUNT, as well as CLIFTOM and JOHM MURCHISOH. COn 3-24-64 JAMES LHETERTO the local office of CIA advised that his office had received information that BUCHANAN reportedly is presentiy employed on an installation of Bull office nachines being usedrbyithe, Prefecture of police in Paxis. This information has been furnished to the Prefecture of police, and while their inquiry is continuingy preliminary results would indicate that the report is untrue。f In this connection, a copy of the memorandum captioned THOHAS GITTINGS BUCEANAN, JR.; which sets forth background information concerning him appearing in Bufiles, and which Was transmitted to the Paris Office by Bulet to Baltinore 3-19-64, was made available to the prefecture of police. It appears that the information contained in the memorandum would be of interest to the Ambassador, RALDH SMITH of the local office of U.S.I.Sorthe Direction de la Surveillance du Territoire (DST), Prench fomestic counterespionage service, Rand the local office of CIA. ${ }^{\text {a }}$ 蔼e are therefore furnishing frepies of that memorandum to them.
