1. Los Juramentados (Those Sworn In), an anti-Castro group, is soliciting aid in the form of arms and munitions, with the intention of waging a war of liberation in Cuba. Vicente Eladio Valdez Valladares, domiciled at No. 4 calle Ballesta, piso 2, Madrid, and Hector Alfonso y Ruiz, domiciled at No. 4 calle Campomanes, piso 4, Madrid, are special delegates of the group in Spain.

2. Los Juramentados is composed of the following Cuban exiles and representatives of anti-Castro groups, among others:

Former Rebel Army Major Raul Diaz Torres y Gomez Calzadilla,

Reinaldo Pico Ramon of the Organizacion Revolucionaria del Transporte (ORT, Transportation Revolutionary Organization),

Jorge Julio Rojas of Tribuna Libre,

Mario Fontela of the Frente Obrero Revolucionario Democratico (FORDC, Cuban Workers' Revolutionary Democratic Front),

Dr. (fnu) Alabau Trelles of the Judiciary in exile,<sup>1</sup>

The College of Newspapermen and Correspondents.

Luis Moreno Alvarez, leader of the 30 November group, one of the brigade members who landed at Playa Giron during the April 1961 invasion;
