Keay FROM SUBJECT CESTABLISHMENT OF CIA REPRESENTATIVE IN CANADA () Reference is made to my memorandum to Mr. Fletcher, dated May 2, 1949, wherein it was noted that CFA contemplated assigning former Bureau Agent Samuel Herman, Horton as a CIA representative in Ottawa, Canada & Reference memorandum also included the fact that Horton was specifically recommended so that he could "properly handle Bethelland thereby gain an entree into the RCMP and related organizations by using Bethellas a $\{U\}$ "Stepping stone". It was also mentioned that the Bureau's liaison representative to CIA had ascertained that William K, Harvey, also a former Bureau Agent, and now a minor officail of CTA, had advised his superiors that Bethal had a "peculiar personality," and , therefore, it would take a good liaison man to handle him properly. The Director noted as follows: "1. What is record of Horton while with us? 21 The attached letter is unsatisfactory. I don't like its evaiiveness. Please rewrite. H." Attached will be found a brief, prepared by the Chief Clerk's office, reflecting former Agent Horton's record with this Bureau. With respect to the Director's second notation, the attached lettler ? been prepared pursuant to his instructions.
