Ashe was assigned to the Richment and Cincinnati Offices and was transferred to the Seat of Government on June 28, 1943. The recommendation was also specifically made that "due to your peculiar personality" Horton should be the new Canadian representative (3) because of his so-called "ability to handle people," meaning of course, that he is expected to cultivate and properly handle you for the benefit of CIA. It is therefore quite evident that CIA personnel are not only unfairly judging you, but also have every intention of using you as a "stepping-Stone" for their own designs.

This information is being pointed out to you so that you may be completely aware of the situation. You should be particularly alert to prevent being used as any such "stepping-stone" for CIA or Horton. CIA should develop its own contacts without depending upon the excellent relationships already established between the FBI and Canadian official channels only that liaison necessary for the coordination of domestic and foreign matters is necessary and it should be most circumspect.
