Reference is made to your communication dated Fine 22, U 1961, your reference CSCI-3/765,934, concerning captioned subject.

This Bureau has no objection to your furnishing your source (in a Swedish security service) the information set forth (II) in paragraph 3 of your communication, providing this Bureau as the source is not revealed. We have not received a separate inquiry from official Swedish sources concerning subject. (S)

NOTE: Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) letter 6-22-61 advises a Swedish security service recently requested a file check on (S) (II) subject who is an applicant for "a position of trust" in Sweden (CIA advises that the Swedish official in asking for information (S) on subject remarked, without elaboration, that subject is possibly (II) a communist (S)

Subject was born in England but is a U.S. citizen. We conducted an investigation of subject in 1952-1953 which eigelosed subject was a subscriber to the Soviet "Information Bulletin in 1949, subscribed to the communist newspaper the "Daily Worker" in 1949 and 1950, was a member of the Miami Council of American-Soviet Friendship in 1946, registered to vote for the American Labor Party in New York City, in 1950, and one Gene De Castro signed a communication to Judge Medina urging a mistrial of the eleven Communist Party leaders in 1949. CIA desires to furnish this information to a Swedish Security services we have no objection. Subject has been in Europe since the latter part of 1950 where he has been principally engaged as a student and a teacher. Letter classified "Secret" since it
