Reference is made to prior FBI reports furnished to recipient agencies concerning the subject as well as the Fair Play for Cuba Committee. There is attached for each recipient a copy of a memorandum dated August 27, 1962, which sets forth the results of an interview of Gibson conducted by our New York Office on August 16, 1962. This interview was undertaken following receipt of information through the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) indicating that the subject was interested in contacting representatives of the U. S. Government, and specifically representatives of CIA. (S) (U)

For the information of CIA and any action deemed warranted Gibson indicated a desire to be contacted by a CIA representative, preferably in Montreal, Canada, although he did not volunteer any details on how this contact might be arranged. (S) (U)
