- 3. EUROPEAN MERCENARIES, MOST OF WHOM DISAPPEARED AT THE
 TIME OF THE MID- (PRTN GARBLED BEING SERVICED) ARE READY TO PARTICIPATE
 IN CASE OF FIGHTING (FIELD COMMENT: SEE ACE 683 (TDCS-3/517,501) FOR A
 PREVIOUS REPORT ON NUMBERS OF MERCENARIES IN ELISABETHVILLE).
- 4. MILITARY SUPPLIES ARE NOW BEING SENT TO ELISABETHVILLE FROM SAKANIA, INSTEAD OF KIPUSHI WHICH WAS THE PORT FROM WHICH SUPPLIES WERE DISTRIBUTED UNTIL RECENTLY, WHERE A NEW SUPPLY BASE HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED. GOODS ARE TRANSPORTED IN TRUCKS OVER SECONDARY ROADS TO AVOID UN SURVEILLANCE.
