- 1. This monorandum contains a suggestion, in Paragraph 3, for the consideration of the DCI.
- 2. On the night of 7 June, President Lopes Mateos requested Ar. Ecott to inform "his good friend, President Elsenhover," of the followings
 - A. That the President is a friend of the United States, "not only because of necessity but of Genuine desire and ideology".
 - B. That the invitation to President Dorticos of Cuba was extended two weeks efter it was indicated that Dorticos was going to Mexico "on his own", through the Fexican Ambassador in Cuba.
 - C. That be will not invite Fidel Castro to Hexico even though Cuban Ambassador Jose Antonio Portucado told President Lopes Hateos that Dorticos will request an invitation for Castro.
- 3. President Loger Nateon also asked that President Eisenbover he informed that he is delighted that a decision has now been made to get rid of Castro.] The DCI may wish to inform the President of the above.
