

It was also learned that the capital stock of the firm is controlled by one Mertiner C. Chaki, Jusior, and a stichard W. Child, both of whom are United states citizens. The indices of this Agency reveal that Mortimer C. Chaki, Junior, of the above mentioned firm is identical with Mortimer Clargett Chaki, Junior, co-owner with Richard William Molas Child of the firm of Bandom TRADING CLMPANY INCLAPARTED, which has offices in Tokyo, Japan, and is improposated under the laws of Pename. - 5. The activities and contacts of George PERSTERUPCULUS aka PERS in Japan and Aurea are currently being investigated by this Agency.
- 6. George S. PERISTEROPCULOS aka PERIS, identified above. and known to William H. MARTIN as "George PARIS", is identical with the individual whom Volentin HAHN aka Valentin Vasiliyevich KHAR aka won-thin HAN, admitted former (1967) Seriet agent, identified as "George PARIS, a Greek businessman in Tchyo", and as one of HARR's close contacts and friends in Japan. It hen interviewed by representatives of this Agency to 1958, Valentine HAHA advised that the above "George PARIS" was the person who introduced HARN to a Takes might club, located off the Cinna, the name of which HAHN gave paly as "The Tomorrew Is Too Late Club". HAHN claimed that this was an exact and direct translation into Luglish of the actual Japanese name, which, bowever, he never mentioned during the interview. Date of HARN's visit to this "club" in company of George PERIS and PARIS, is estim-ted to have been comewhere between 1954 and 1957. HAMM stated that hi the "Temorrow Is Too Late Club' he was introdeced to a Japanese hostess by the name of Northo MATSUZAKATA alias Northo AWAIL with whom HAHN aphaequently enjoyed dates. It is believed that Noriko MATSUZAKAYA & AWAJI became the mistross of Valentine HANV for an undetermined period of time following his original introduction to her at the above "Club" while in the company of George PERISTEALPCULES ake PERIS ake PARIS. - 8. No additional information, to supplement that which is reported in paragraph 6 above, identifiable with Nortko MAYSUZAKAYA G AWAIL would be located in the indices of this Agency.

With reference to the 'Tomorrow is Too Late Club', mentioned in paragraph 5 above, to which Velentine HAMN claims to have been taken by George PARIS, an exact and direct re-translation of the club name into Japanese from the English as given by HAHA, would read "Asu de wa Canaugira". It is noted that the Takyo Telephone Directory for 1957 contains a listing for an octablishment of this name, as follows: ASU Da WA LBUSUCIAU, located at Chio-ku, Ginsa, 8-Cheme, 3 Banchi, Tokyo-to, Telephone Nee.: 57-9945, 57-6363, 57-6528. A reliable source, who is familiar with the city of Tokyo, advised in Uctober 1769, that as of 1759 this establishment was still operating at the listed location, and that it is a colice-house rather than a nightclub in the western senso, although alcoholic beverages are available for consumption on the premises by the pairous. The same source also advised that the above collee-house employs Japanese hostesses", as is customary in each establishments In Japan, and that such females might be dated under the circumeleaces indicated by Valentine MARN. MARTIN and Valentine HARN with George PERISTERCPCULCE she PERIS, and in turn, PERIS role vis-a-vis HARN's introduction to the ASU DE WA (SCSUCIRU coffee-house, it is suggested that PERIS may have played a similar role to terms of introducing william MARTIN to Japanese night-life. This may have eventually led to MARTIN's contact and involvement with Japanese individuals, who introduced him to or indulged his masschistic interests.
- 11. Additional information on the individuals mentioned above will be forwarded as developed. It is requested that addressess forward to this Agency any information on George PERISTERCPCULCS aka PERIS, his contacts and activities, and on the other individuals mentioned herein.
