- 1. According to a newspaper column of "Allen and Scott" in the Chicago American of 6 December 1963, on the 0 MALD Case, Abram (HAYEN. Legal Officer of the State Separtment, was one of two persons insulately responsible for 6 MALD's being permitted to return to the United States from the Seriet Union in June 1962. The other individual named was Lieuwillyn THOMESCE, the then Anhassador to Buncia. Another said to have been involved in the handling of OSSALD's case was Samuel WISE, Counsel of the American Embassy in Moscow.
- 2. Abras CRAYES, 3352234, who as of 16 Pebruary 1961 was described as "the new Commsel in State", was granted lecurity approval for limison contact with J. Poster COLLEGY in the office of the Chief of the Covert Action Staff) on 6 Parch 1961. The request for CRAYES' clearance was a "Blanket' request to permit discussion with him of MSC 5412/2 ratters on a need-to-know tasis.
- 3. In September 1961 there was a White House namecheck request on CHAYES' wife Amtonia (Toni) Leigh CHAYES, nee: HAMDLER.
- b. In March 1962, CHAYES was granted a renewal of his limited contact clearence with C/CA on a continuing basis. This time his contact was Architekle ROOFFYELD, Jr.
- 5. On 10 February 1962, EMHAN EVENTS reported as follows with reference to CHAYES:

"SOFT ON CONCENTEM: Representative Francis E. Walter (R.-Pa.), Chairman of the House Committee on Un-American Activities, has scored the new State Department regulations on passports, claiming they would allow Reds denied passports to "rifle freely the confidential files of the Phi, the CIA and other investigative agencies." The man behind the new regulations, which calter claims violate the Internal Security Act of 1750, is reportedly State's chief legal officer, Abram Chayes. Chayes, a Kennedy appointee, is an ex-Herverd professor who was Checter Bowles' top legal advicer when Bowles was Governor of Connecticut. Walter has introduced legislation to resedy the new passport regulations."

- 6. Samuel WISE, "Counsel in the American Fabassy in Moscow" who is referred to above, any well be Samuel Griffin WISE Jr., 17-574, ED & Th., who apparently was once a contract employee on ACR TIME. The State Repartment reviewed WISE's file on 2 June 1954; and as of toptember 1962 a Samuel G. WISE was Second Secretary of the American Saturdary in Moscow. At that time WISE advised in a cable to the State Department that it appeared that bruce Frederick DAVID, 352057, who defected from the United States Fray in Sermany on 13 August 1960, had not experiented himself. DAVIS' case is very similar to that of OTMAD; and he; like OSWALD, lived in the Soviet Union for two years after his defection and prior to making application for return to the United States.
 - 7. First was an applicant for CIA employment in early 1993 and was security approved subject to polygraph on 11 August 1995. He did not enter on duty and in September 1995 the office which had been interested in him was 'no longer interested". On 13 Hovember 1993, WISE was granted a CEA to permit his use as a contract employee on AMACTIVE in New York City. His CMA was cancelled on 25 March 1993.
- 8. WHE was marsed as a friend of William Cryille MUNIAL, 61693-DL. during an investigation of the latter for possible (TA employment in 1952. WICE, according to MEMPIL's landledy and social acquaintance in Dashington, D.C. during the period of about a year which ended in April 1992, was the only person she knew by mane with whom MAMPIL was friendly. According to the informant, WITE was a student at Columbia University whose address was \$23 Furnald Hall. MAMPIL was recurity disapproved for TA employment in June 1962 because of his above association on a professional and social basis, while attending Denver University from 1996 to 1991, with persons of questionable loyality. In Movember 1994, PUNIALL was of interest to project MIALIVS with reference to assignment to Dinhran, Javid Arabia; however, the interested office withdrew their request on him, after Security advised of the derogatory information regarding him.
- 9. WISE from 1951 to 195% attended Scaradale High School in Scaradale, New York, which was attacked by a Citizense Group, which alleged Communist influence in the school system. He had several questionable associates in addition to MINCEL.
