SUBJECT: Release of Stations and Bases

REFERENCE: Memo DD/095-3059, dated 7 Nov. 95, subject
release of JFK documents

1. Per phone conversation with Bill McNair, DO/IRO, on 13 November 1995, the German and Swiss locations not addressed in the referenced memorandum are to be treated the same as the primary station/base that is listed in that memorandum:

Bern and Lausanne - same as Geneva (protect);

Frankfurt, Hamburg, Munich, and Stuttgart
- same as Berlin and Bonn ("no specific damage",
i.e. release in Oswald 201).

2. The above information was given to ARRB staff via phone message left on J. Gunn's voice mail, 13 November 1995.
