6. LASTLY, SOURCE IDENTIFIED ROLANDO OTERO HERNANDEZ, A CUBAN EXILE, AS THE PERSON CASTRO SAID HAD CONTACT RESPONSIBILITIES BETWEEN CUBAN EXILES IN MIAMI AND CUBAN EXILES IN SANTIAGO, CHILE.

OTERO, ACCORDING TO SOURCE, IS NOW IN MIAMI. (HEADQUARTERS COMMENT: THE NUMBER OF CUBAN EXILES IN SANTIAGO IS MINISCULE.)

- 7. ON 28 SEPTEMBER 1977 THE SANTO DOMINGO STATION OBTAINED THE SOURCED TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHOSE RELIABILITY HAS NOT BEEN ESTABLISHED.
- REPUBLIC SOMETIME BETWEEN 19 AND 21 JUNE 1976, PROBABLY IN BONAO IN A HOUSE TRAILER. THOSE CUBAN EXILES IN ATTENDANCE WERE IDENTIFIED AS JORGE ALONSO RUJOLS, ERNESTO HERNANDEZ, PABLO MARTIN, FRANK TEIRA, LUI ROSS, JOSE AGUILA, WILFREDO BLANCO, LEVI MARRERO, JOSE LUIS PRADO, ANDRES SARGEN, JORGAS CANOSA, JUAN MPEREZ LEBANCO, FREDDY LUGO, GERMAN LOZANO, ORLANDO BOSCH, FERNANDO BUENO, AND GUILLERMO NOVO.
