Reference is made to Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) letter dated April 18, 1963, captioned "U. S. Nationals in Cuba." The Liaison Agent was instructed to obtain more specific information concerning subject's reported travel to Cuba. The following was furnished to the Liaison Agent on July 3, 1963, by A. P. Flynn, CIA:

Information received by CIA indicated that the subject was in Cuba during the period February 22-March 11, 1963. CIA received this information from the British Intelligence Service (MI-6). The British obtained the data from Gavin Young, a British newspaperman who was in Cuba during the same period described above. MI-6 has advised CIA that Young is currently traveling to San Francisco. The British MI-6 representative in Washington, D. C. plans to contact Young and work out arrangements whereby Young can be made available to the Bureau for interview.
