I was received this morning, Friday 3 January at 1100 hours by Philippine Foreign Minister LOPEZ. He told me that America is ready to forget entirely the incident with Cambodia since Cambodia has already denied having manifested any rejoicing over the death of [President] KENNEDY. President MACAPAGAL had an interview yesterday with Mr. LOPEZ and American Ambassador STEVENSON. The Philippine [Government] thinks that Cambodia and America will be willing to forget any past incident and so will accept the formula of a joint statement.

President MACAPAGAL and Mr. LOPEZ wish sincerely to receive a trusted representative of His Royal Highness in an interview in Manila. But if, on the contrary, His Royal Highness wishes for President MACAPAGAL to send a Philippine representative to Phnom Penh, the President will conform with the desire of His Royal Highness. Meanwhile, the Philippine Foreign Minister is ordering Ambassador FAROLAN to return from Saigon. Unfortunately FAROLAN's son just died in an accident in Hong Kong.
