President's visit to U.S.; communication number two.

1. The President's official party arrived safely as scheduled at Dulles [International] Airport at 12:30 in the morning of 25 November.

2. At the airport they were received by a large number of official members of the U.S. State Department such as Undersecretary of State GEORGE BALL, Assistant Undersecretary of State ROGER HILSMAN in charge of the Far East, Director of the office of Far East Affairs MARSHALL GREEN and the Deputy Director of the office of East Asian Affairs LEONARD BACON along with members of the Embassy and approximately 150 fellow countrymen who were studying abroad.

3. The return date is not decided upon but it is certain that they will leave as planned upon the completion of the formal reception by each country's officials for President JOHNSON on Tuesday, 26 November.
