WORLD HIGHLIGHTS

1. VENEZUELAN AIR DETACHMENT HAS ORDERS TO DESTROY ENEMY PLANES OVER VENEZUELAN TERRITORY

Beginning at 1330Z on 25 November, the newly established Venezuelan "Capri" air detachment, has been ordered to co-ordinate with navy units to intercept, destroy or counteract enemy air incursions of Venezuelan territory. This air detachment, to be stationed at Coro (11-25N 69-41W), will also join navy and national guard units in patrolling the coast of Falcon state.

Several U/I planes have been reported over since 7 October. The establishment of the "Capri" detachment elements defensive measures ordered on 28 October against planes suspected of supplying the guerrillas of Falcon. These flights, according to previous Venezuelan military reports, are apparently conducted on Mondays, Thursdays and Saturdays at 1930 hours. (3/0/VEM/R02-63, 30 Oct 2113Z, 3/0/VEM/R12-63, 242001Z). 2. GUINEAN: CHOU EN-LAI MAY VISIT AFRICA IN DECEMBER

Guinean representative BANGOURA in Peking informed President TOURE that he had learned unofficially that Premier CHOU EN LAI will leave Peking on 13 or 14 December to visit Egypt and other African countries, including Guinea, Ghana and Mali. He was unable to confirm the information with Chinese protocol because, he believed, they were being discreet in order to avoid an assassination attempt such as President LIU SHAO CHI had experienced in a visit to Cambodia. 3. HAVANA REACTIONS TO KENNEDY ASSASSINATION

The reaction in Havana to the death of President KENNEDY was calm but cautious, according to a report from the Chilean

Ambassador there on 23 November. Only isolated Communist groups have shown any rejoicing. Radio and news reels are giving objective

The report of an attack on Portuguese border troops was confirmed in a Portuguese message of 21 November. The Operations Chief of Staff at Luanda was informed by a Portuguese military officer that insurgents, probably with the aid of bazooka and mortar, had attacked an Internal security police (PIDE) post.

The second sentence of the second paragraph should be changed to read: As a result of this attack, reinforcements, consisting of 81 Mortar Section and a Cascadores (Commando)
Platoon were to be immediately dispatched to occupy the area of the Border Guard and PIDE frontier posts at Massabi. (TOP SECRIT DIMAR)
