COLONEL PHAM NGOC THAO. STRATEGIC HAMLET INSPECTOR FOR NGO DINH NHU AND MEMBER OF BOTH THE TUYEN GROUP AND THE GROUP LED BY HUYNH VAN LANG. ECONOMICS PROFESSOR AT SAIGON UNIVERSITY, HAD GIVEN HIM THIS THAO HAD ALSO TOLD DUONG THAT GENERALS DUONG VAN MINH, INFORMATION.
