 SVESTKA EXPRESSED CONCERN THAT ASSASSINATION WILL HAVE DELAYING

 ACTION ON IMPROVED EAST-WEST RELATIONS: UNDER KENNEDY THINGS

 WERE MOVING QUICKLY TOWARDS UNDERSTANDING, AND CHANGE OF PRESIDENT

 NOW WILL OF NECESSITY SLOW DOWN THE COURSE OF EVENTS BECAUSE

 "PERSONAL FACTOR" IS NOW MISSING. KENNEDY HAD DEVELOPED CONTACTS

- 4. ON 29 NOVEMBER, RUMANIAN AMBASSADOR MIRCEA BALANESCU SAID HE WAS CERTAIN THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE IN BLOC POLICY VIS-A-VIS WEST AND ANY INCREASE IN TENSION WOULD BE RESULT OF CHANGED AMERICAN POLICY.
