4. REPORT OF FINDINGS

(EDUCATION INTERVIEW) On 8 October 1968, Herbert Tandlich of 501 Riverdale Avenue, Yonkers, New York, former instructor of Manuel MARTI at Evander Childs High School, Bronxwood Avenue and East Gun Hill Road, Bronx, New York, was interviewed at the school and stated substantially as follows:

Source first met SUBJECT in September of 1963 and had HIM as a student in the "shop course" until June of 1964. SUBJECT was an excellent student to the best of Source's memory and he had daily contact with HIM on an instructor-student basis. Source did not know anything about SUBJECT'S family nor where HE resided. HE was considered to be mentally stable and mature without any memberships in any political organizations. Source had no knowledge of SUBJECT'S association with HIS father and could not comment on the degree of influence exercised by HIS father over HIM.

Source considered SUBJECT to be loyal to the United States form of government and recommends that HE be considered favorably for a position of trust and responsibility with the United States government.
