Case concerning SUBJECT is forwarded for appropriate action.

- 2. The Assistant Chief of Staff for Intelligence adheres to his determination, as stated in Comment Number 1, that induction of SUBJECT into military service is inconsistent with the interests of national security. However, the determination of The Judge Advocate General that the proposed allegations should not be drawn for the reason stated in Comment Number 2, precludes rejection of SUBJECT for security reasons under present policy.
- 3. In the event it is determined that SUBJECT is declared acceptable for induction, recommend that appropriate personnel records be annotated to preclude HIS receiving access to classified information.
- 4. Request that the file be returned through the Director of Security, Assistant Chief of Staff for Intelligence, to the Chief, United States Army Personnel Security Group, Fort Holabird, Maryland 21219, upon completion of your action.
