In accordance with a policy decision to keep DKHERALD contact with U.S. business representatives discreet, a small luncheon was held in lieu of the customary formal briefings in the Headquarters building. <u>KIDACETONE-1</u>, IDENTITY 1, David C. HIGBY and Floyd N. AIMONET attended the luncheon which was characterized by cordiality and candor. <u>KIDACETONE-1</u> waited until the conclusion of the meeting to raise his current favorite subject, that of countering the leftist propaganda contained in SIEMPRE. Fortunately, HIGBY was forewarned and effectively turned around the thrust of the effort upon <u>KIDACETONE-1</u>'s shoulders, without offending him. IDENTITY impressed HIGBY with his interest, intelligence and sincerity.
