- 1. The SW supplies and instructions needed to establish two-vay SW correspondence with AMRE) are transmitted herevith. We realize that some of the instruction forms and supplies which are being transmitted are duplicates of those sent to the Station in support of other operations. However, in order to facilitate the handling of each operation, the supplies for each are furnished as a complete unit. This will proclude the need for berrowing from one agent's supplies to outfit another.
- 2. ANTRE will write to the Cuse Officer, using carbon system [39337. Two unused sheets of carbon [37337 should be issued to the agent for this purpose. He should be told to store them separately to avoid accidental loss of his writing system. His carbon system is developed by means of tablet [30607. A supply of the developer material, in quantities sufficient for training purposes, accompanies this dispatch.
- 3. According to the WH operational plan, SW messages written by ANGUED vill be mailed to accommodation addresses in various Latin American countries. In accordance with that, KURIOT will provide the appropriate (WH Field Stations) 25 with the materials accessary for developing the operational messages.
- 4. AMERIA will develop the SW messages be receives by means of pill 99 #58838. He should be issued twenty pills #58838 for that purpose. It is recommended that the agent be told to hide his developer materials in a safe place. This should not present much of a problem because the pills are so 99 wmall. We do not generally recommend that pills be concurraged as medicines. 99 Even in cases where the SW ingredient does have a bone fide medicinal usage, the concentration represented by the SW pill would usually be in excess of the probability and thus there would be a danger of having an unwitting person use them by accident quif the Case Officer feels that for operational reasons it is desirable to ensouflage them as medicines, they should only be kept in a bottle which is clearly marked for EXCLUDIAL USE OURY 99
- 5. According to the operational plan, the Dame to agent Si messages will be prepared for the Area Division by KURIOT at Mendquarters. The Area Division will pouch the Si pessages (3 "blank" sheets of stationers) to the appropriate Field Station for application of the cover test and uniling.
- 6. The Addical Case Officer should femiliarize himself with the accompanying supplies and instructions before any attempt is made to train and issue supplies to the agent. Experience has shown that it is advicable to plan for two or three short (2 hour) agent training sessions scheduled over a period of days, rather than to attempt to crum the training into one long session.
- 7. Special attention should be given to planning the cover correspondence. It is usually reconscuded that the agent use (false name and return address) on his SW messages to the Station, thereby dis-associating himself completely from his SW reports once, they are in the tail channel. (This requires that the correspondence be fictional, and entails a certain amount of skill on the part of AMIR his fabricatin; apparently (magent correspondence) Which have found that the use of a false postal identity) frequently provides the agent with considerable psychological reconsurance during the course of the operation.

- 8. The cover correspondence must in no way appear to be different from the bulk of mail ordinarily found in the example being used. It should contain no information which could be viewed as suspicious in any way. The external appears of the correspondence must be imposent in all aspects if the SM is to be expected to provide any level of security.
- 9. We have found that the reliability of any 5% system depends nearly entirely on the care with which it is used. Please stress the need for careful writing techniques in your agent training sessions.
- 10. The following supplies and instructions are transmitted in support of the AMES operation:

a. Standard Form (1059-CWT) which describes in detail how to write (with a campon wheet)

- b. One carbon sheet (2010), labeled (DENONSTRATION CARBON) is to be used to demonstrate the principles of (carbon) writing. The development process for this system can be carried out in the agent's presence.
- c. One (bottle (100 ml.) of developer (20509) which will develop the demonstration (surbod) writing.
- 40 d. Instruction (Form/H-16029) describing the development of the (DE-ONSTRATION CARBON)
- e. (Three carbon sheets #39337) The one inbeled (FRACTICE CARBON) is to be used in training and is to be retained by the Station. (Two) 99 are to be issued to the agent. The agent should not be allowed to vitcess the development of this system, nor should he be shown the pessage after development.
- f. Instruction form 11-36037) specific instructions for the development (of carbon system #39337) 97
- c. Grenty pills \$30607, to be used to develop practice and real messages written 6th carbon \$39337)99
- h. Two practice messages written with AMERE's ingoing SW system which he should use to practice his development technique.
- i. (Twenty-five pills 15838) which Au(RE) vill use to develop the St messages he received. Two or three (of these pills) should be used in training. (Twenty of the remaining pills) should be issued to the agent.
- 9 j. Instruction form #R-26058) instructions for the use of developer #56938.)
 - k. One copy of the "Station Maintenance of SN Supplies form.
- 1. Miscellaneous items such as cotton, swab sticks, and blotters; items generally useful for 5% processing.
- 11. You will note that two different kinds of (carbon sheets) have been submitted with the supplier. One is labeled (DEMONSTRATION CARBON) This should be used in the practice session only. It should be used to demonstrate (carbon) writing techniques to the agent. This system can be developed in the agent's presence. The other farbons submitted (137337) constitute the agent's operational sending system (one sheet of carbon 139337) has been labeled (PRACTICE CARBON) That the agent has mastered the use of the DEPONSTRATION CARBON to should be given an apportunity to write with the (PRACTICE CARBONOP) It is very important that the Case Officer have the chance to critique the agent's SW writing technique with the actual system which the agent will use.
