In replying to the remarks of Colonel Peralta I said that we appreciate the cooperation of Guatemala in the 24 OA; and that we shall be most interested in the epiloitation of the possibilities in the present case. I added that the matter of using force against Cuba is a policy matter on which I was not competent to comment but that the decisions made by the United states Government are based on careful study of detailed information including information on Soviet intentions and capabilities.
