This is brought to your attention so that you will be able to take appropriate action to prevent any compromise of activities at the Subject Covert Site.
- 3. For your information a search of Office of Security Indices in the names of the individuals listed in the attached report has failed to reveal any additional noteworthy or derogatory information identifiable with them.
- 4. Under no circumstances may classified material be stored in the Subject Covert Site. In addition, the Subject Covert Site may not be loaned to or utilized by another component of the Agency without the prior concurrence of the Central Covert Staff, the Safehouse Procurement-Branch, Office of Logistics and this office.

Visual and technical benefication may be possible from the land area surrounding SUBJECT SITE building and from the parking lot located approximately fifteen yards to the south of SUBJECT SITE building and SUBJECT SITE. No other security hazards were noted and the closest building to SUBJECT SITE building a approximately fifty yards away.
