SUBJECT

Report on Caban Operations for Veriod 1-15 September 61

This is the second summary report of activities in Cuban operations, and covers the period 1-15 September 1961. This report will consist of a breakdown of such operations into the principal setematics of activity.

A. PI-CL ACCIVITY

1. Reporting to Headquarters. There was a total of twentyeight reports received during the period, and they
escaleted of the following: Nine from 21 courses, fifteen
from decriofings conducted in the Migni erec, two via the
open mail, and two reports via diplomatic couries. Additionally, cleven CI reports were passed to the FBI, and
1,017 CI name checks were processed for 1623.

2. Agent Activition and Developments

- a. There was a total of eighteen agents within Cuba at the beginning of the reporting period and twenty-four by the period's close.
- b. Comment: Of the cover agents dispatched legally during the period, one agent was a returnee. These agents should provide increased coverage of anti-Costro groups, activities at the disport and new entress into the diplomatic consumity.
- c. Four agents were recruited and two agents were terminated during the period.
- d. In ecoperation with the Corman deak, we have initiated an operation to debrief Cuban sailors who pean through

the area. Clearences have been elitained for two Cubana who will act as coordinators for the operation.

- e. AVCELT-1, a Gruguayan diplomat, has been recruited and has agreed to act as a courier for the intel met in Caba. The agent is currently on his way to Cuba via boat.
- f. AHOT-34, the principal agent/WY operator, using signal plan CRAKIK, returned to Cuba via legal means on 6 september and was once again in radio communication with me as of 10 september. He is in contact with AMMES-1, the principal agent of what remains of our intelligence set in Cuba.
- g. Control of the CGARIX W/T communication link was passed to WAVE from Headquarters offsetive 14 September.
- h. AMPALN-1 was dispatched to Comeve to attempt to recruit Raul CETTRO Benilla, Minister of the Estional Bank of Cuba, who is presently attending the sugar conference in Switherland.
- i. Jesus LOPEZ Guerrara, Cuban sirling pilot who is disaffected with the Castro regime, is in contact with the Madrid Station and has agreed to cooperate and remain in place.
- Arrangements are being made for a technical surveillance of the charge office in the Cubas Embassy, Homtovideo.

B. Propaganda Activity

1. Fajor Efforts

a. Operation Poliver. Designed to place sixty student/
exents of the Directorio Revolutionario Estudiantil
(DRE) exile group is universities throughout the
Western Hemisphere. Progress: Three in place and
twenty-one are processing.

- h. Operation Virgen del Cobre. Designed to exploit the Eucreber amiversary of the Cuben patron saint as a day of sourning expressing opposition to Castro's attacks upon the church, religious freedom, and Cuben freedom. Progress: All local and Sestem Besisphere sussts alerted for the Susptember campaign. Sixty-five thousand pieces of propagands were distributed for mailing throughout Latin America. The Cruzada Fomisina Cubena (CFC) worm's group sent eight cables and 130 letters in the Latin American area. Through the joint efforts of the CFC and Catholics, ness and benediction services were held before 25,000 people in the Hismi stadies. It was said to be a bage success.
- e. After the recent Castro executions, an emecty tempolyn was initiated on tohalf of political and military prisoners. Progress: One hundred and eight cables and 220 letters were sent to Latin America by the Cuben affiliate groups.

- c. The Avence newspaper sponsored twenty-four thirty minute progress over Whit, Missi, targeted against northern Newses and Materiaes provinces on general anti-Castro thomas. Seem broadcasts ten end one half bours daily over short and sedium wave.
- b. We support a Cuben exile group producing a weekly thirty minute tape for distribution to a number of Caribbean basia stations, and a weekly fifteen minute tape for distribution through IAAB channels to Central and South American stations. At present some accounty stations participate in this operation.
- s. WAVE has assumed contect role with local offices of Swan and radio broadcaster Luis CONTE Aguero through cutout.
- d. Beginning Il September, Luis CONTE Agnero began short wave breadcasts of thirty minutes daily on five frequencies beared to all Central and South America and Caribbean bests.

- b. Maritime broadcasts were expectled for pariod for vessel maintenance. An electronic engineer has been hired and construction of TV intrusion equipment has begun. This equipment will be used on the maritime broadcast and be targeted against the Usvana area.
- f. Cuban Presides Committee funded and directed two hours daily ever WGBS, Missi, and siz hours daily ever WEWF, May West.

5. Tours and Trevel - Cuben Group Representation

- a. DRE. Two tours covering Brazil, Gruguey, Argentine, and Chile.
- b. CFC. Two tours covering Chile, Bolivia, Argentina, Fera, Econdor, Colombia and Fanana.
- e. Rerious MULTA. To kie medical congress.
- d. Arrangements are in process to send a small variety troops to henico for propaganda value. The performance will be filted on 15 km for subsequent general use throughout Latin America.
- e. Arrangements were made with the State Department by WN/4/Security for the facilitation of re-entry into the United States of long-term Coben assets dispatched on propaganda tours of Contral and South America.
- 6. Cther Activition. Readquarters representative met with Rojas Santamariza, and discussed his plan for FRAFFOR project, i.e., sotablishment of phantom cells inside Caba through medium of propaganda chair letters. Headquarters is studying the idea with a view to possible trial-rum on a small scale.

C. Political Action Activity

1. CRC. A meating was held 9 september with Dr. Miro Cardona at which time he was advised by higher authority that our Government regards the CRC so the control point of contact in its dealing with the Cuben exile and underground activity. A basic administrative budget will be allocated, and it will be in the meighborhood of a million deliars par year. All other allocations of money will be on the basis of specific projects submitted by the Council and approved by the United States. The Cuben Council will continue to broaden its base allowing entry of all substantial exile groups not identified with Batista or with

Communica. Groups not willing to surk with the Council will be dealt with bilaterally (the United States and the group involved), but Dr. Miru will be kept informed of these activities. Such information will be kept in the strictest secrecy by Dr. Miro and his specially appointed assistant. If this arrangement should prove insecure, such contacts will terminate. All problems arising from Council activities will be discussed become the CEC and the Eureau of ANA of State Department. Dr. Miro will maintain his contact with the White House for cases wherein be considered such contact to be urgently necessary.

2. Additional Political Developments. After high lavol United States condideration and decision, Dr. Miro was inforced, at a meeting on 16 September, that the responsibility for the organization and plans for eatle Cuban jurious and lawyers would be his. In addition, to his future funding "salaries" of the existing ALASAU organiaction, \$3,000 per south would be provided by. Hiro or his designee retroactive to 1 August to support Dr. Hiro's faction of lawyers to whom he has a long utsteling complement. It was empired and that this transfer of responsibility must be accomplished harmoniously, without adverse press reaction, or support of this mork would be withdrawn. Col. Rendell Johnson was hired and will be piaced in contact with Dr. Miro prior to 1 October. Re will function as the day-to-day contact between Dr. Miro and this Agency and the United States Government. It was made clear to hr. Hiro that his demand for responsibility as exclusive channel to the other professional groups, 1.s., students and labor, was rejected. He was told that any proposals be might wish to make in the student and labor fields would be relatived as promoting harmony and eventual unity of Cuhan exile anti-Castro elaments.

D. Paramilitary Activity

1. Heritics Activity

a. Right vessels, four Agency owned and four Cobam owned, are available to support this activity. Of the eight respels, five were operational and three were endargoing repairs during the period. The principal activity during the period revolved around preparation and aspport of operation TEABAR, to be implemented 16 September.

- b. The LCI, RABARA J, is now assiting additional engineering and electrical work at the Jan Juan Brydock Company. Policy has been caused by the lack of priority and the induction of several Ravy ships requiring urgent repairs.
- c. Captain TIRADO has spotted a complete crow for the BARRARA J and craw names and biographic date have been submitted to Headquarters for elegamee.
- d. The Cover and Commercial Staff is angaged in previding for the chips registration, name change, and gover mechanism to allow for future funding and operation.

2. Agent Activities and Developments

- a. There was a total of forty-two III assets involved in activities during the period. Inside Cube there were two agents, a principal agent and a radio operator. Externally, there were forty agent assets composed of thirty-five III types and five radio operators.
- b. Approval was granted for the passage of RS-6 radio gear complete with signal plan, pade and crystals into Cuba via AMELESS-3 channels which utilize a foreign diplomatic coarier.
- c. Approval was granted for the conduct of operation SPIKE, an exhibitration operation to be implemented ?? September.
- d. In 9 depleader cover ANALY egents were terminated legving a total of thirty in the group.
- e. The internal PA/WT operator EMRIQUE using signal plan MUTLAX reports that his group has been operating a claudestine radio broadcast sizes 12 September (Radio

G. Support

1. Bases

- HAVE. Mineteen staff agents were processed at Hoodquarters and disputched PCS to VAVE bringing the total of PCS personnel to 21 at the close of the period. The renovation of new offices at HAVE is complete.
- b. RTG. Now has responsibility for relaying all traffic to and from VAVE and crypto relay responsibility for all BAGH traffic. The Office of Communications has received their approved T/O for RTM and have commanded personnel actions on approximately fifty personnel assigned at this installation.
- s. The transfer of ATIG to the Office of Legistics
 - hr. Glee Lansy, VH/4/Legistics, is now at JrFIG for the purpose of adjesting the inventory pending arrangements to be made to transfer all Wi exterial held by JrFIG to Supply Division, Office of Legistics.
 - 2) The Planning Staff, Office of Logistics, has acted as coordinator in matters portaining to personnel, finance, cover and security, the majority of which have been or will be settled shortly.
 - 3) Present plans contemplate the release of Jayld to the Office of Legistics on 1 October 1961.
- d. All material at ATTOE has been inventoried and prepared for shipment. Although the intended carrier, the ship JOHAH, arrived at ATTOE on 13 september, loading was delayed due to the presence of foreign shipping in the area. It is anticipated that loading will commence on or about 18 september and will be completed within four days.

e. IRELED. A deaft of a lease agreement for the IREAR property has been prepared and forwarded to the owner of the real estate for final approval.

2. Finança

- a. Answers have been received from various sources regarding our quaries for new Cuben pesos. Two sources are in the process of procuring pesos in the assemt of \$10,000 U.S. dollars.
- b. The funding for MAUSE is in process. Mr. Eall, VE/4/Pinance, is at UAVE to establish a commercial set of records for maintenance by the field office.
- e. Total PV 1962 obligations through 13 September for Ceban operations are \$4,675,919.00. Of this total, \$1,674,775.00 represents payments for the maintenance of the CRC and payments for dependents of the strike force through September.

There is a special intelligence amon to this report, "Counterrevolutionary Activities in Cuba," for the period 1-15 September, issued separately.
