OLTMANS' LETTER WAS AN EXPRESSION OF INTEREST IN THE SENATE INVESTIGATIONS AND PARTICULARLY IN ANY ASPECT REGARDING INDUNESIA. OLTMANS CLAIMED TO HAVE KNOWN SUKARNO OUTTE WELL. AND SAID THAT HE HAD HAD SEVERAL DISCUSSIONS WITH SUKARNO ON THE SUBJECT OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE CIA AND HOW THE CIA WAS TRYING TO OUST SUKARNO. DEWI SUKARNO'S TWO LETTERS WERE REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION ON THE RESULTS OF THE SENATE INVESTIGATION AND HOPED THAT THE INQUIRIES WOULD SERVE TO CLEAR HER HUSBAND'S NAME.

SINCE THE LETTERS WERE ACTUALLY WRITTEN TO SENATOR FRANK CHURCH AS HEAD OF THE SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE, CAGUAR FOUND IT INTERESTING THAT AGEE WOULD BE ABLE TO OBTAIN COPIES OF LETTERS WRITTEN TO A U.S. SENATOR IN HIS OFFICIAL CAPACITY AS HEAD OF SUCH A COMMITTEE.
