May 27, 1962 - April 1969 - Composed correspondence dealing with numerous facets of constituent inquiries concerning legislation, federal agencies, government publications, casework and academies. General office duties including dictation, typing and filing. Acquired a thorough working knowledge of all aspects of a Congressional office.
