- 1. Strangely enough, we have been unable to develop any real information on James F. Quaid, Jr.
- 2. I recall that Mr. Musulin said that Quaid's letter was written on the letterhead of a law firm called Baldwin and Quaid.
- 3. We are unable to locate any such law firm, either in the city directory or the city telephone directory.
- 4. According to Martindale Hubbell, James F. Quaid, Jr. was born in New Orleans on 21 April 1933. He received his preparatory education at Loyola University and his legal education at the same institution. He received a B.B.A. degree in 1954 and an LL.B. degree in 1960 from Loyola. He was admitted to the Louisiana Bar in 1960. He is a member of the Jefferson Parish Bar Association, the Louisiana State Bar Association, and the American Bar Association. In 1964-1965 he was an associate in the firm of Leon A. Pradel, 920 National Bank of Commerce Building, New Orleans, and his telephone number was given as 524-7504, which is Pradel's present telephone number.
- 5. Mr. Pradel received his LL.B. from Tulane in 1937 and from 1946 to 1947 he was Regional Counsel, National Housing Agency, in Seattle, Washington. From 1948 to 1957 he was an associate of Robert R. Ramos, an attorney in New Orleans, Louisiana, and from 1957 to 1960 he was a partner in the firm of Steeg, Shushan and Pradel.
- 6. The city directory lists James F. Quaid (Marie), Lawyer, 210 Baronne Street (this is the National Bank of Commerce Building), Room 927. The city directory also lists James F. Quaid (Florence B.), President, Bank of Louisiana in New Orleans, 246 Loyola Avenue; home, 428 20th Street. I assume that the James F. Quaid whose office is shown as the National Bank of Commerce Building should have been Jr. The telephone directory for the city of New Orleans lists James F. Quaid, Jr., Attorney, National Bank of Commerce Building, telephone 522-5212, if no answer dial 525-8378.
- 7. The Building Directory of the National Bank of Commerce Building lists James F. Quaid, Jr., Room 1748. The door at 1748 has the names of John J. Cummings III, Robert R. Gisevius and Robert G. Heller, Attorneys. Quaid's name does not appear on the door.
