Dear Admiral Turner:

Pursuant to our investigation into the deaths of President John F. Kennedy and Dr. Martin Luther King we may upon occasion call current or former employees of the CIA for interviews, depositions or hearings with the Committee or our staff. When the individuals called incur travel expenses nor normally assumed by the CIA, the Committee will pay these expenses, within the normal limits authorized by the Committee for its witnesses, which ordinarily include coach class air transportation, fifty dollars per diem for meals and lodging, and local transportation expenses.

I understand that, as a matter of expedience and security, the Agency will advance and account for such travel funds utilizing the travel regulations followed by the Committee.

Upon receipt from the Agency of a statement of the total expenses authorized for each case and a certification that all expenses were proper under Committee travel regulations, the Committee will reimburse the Agency. I understand that receipts, true names and travel itineraries will be deleted from your statement and certification for security purposes, but that these shall be available for review by appropriately cleared Committee staff at your office.

I trust these arrangements will be acceptable and thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
