Dear Mr. Breckinridge:

In connection with the investigation by this Committee into the circumstances surrounding the death of President John F. Kennedy and Dr. Martin Luther King, I write to request of the Agency that it provide to the Committee by July 17, 1978 (1) a list of all requests for files made by the Committee of the Agency and $(\bar{2})$ an indication next to each file request as to whether or not the agency has such files. The list should state which of the offices within the Agency have been asked to respond in reference to a particular request, and what the response of that office was. With respect to each office which reports having a file, the list should state whether such file is available for review by our staff as of July 17th.

Any request made by the Committee prior to June 30, 1978, which is not listed in your list of July 17, 1978 as being either ready for review, or for which there is no file, will be considered by the Committee to be a request which was not complied with by the Agency.
