In London, meanwhile, police said they had evidence Ray may have robbed a bank. They said the evidence is fingerprints on a "give me cash" note handed a

The note was handed to a teller in the Trustee Savings Bank June 4-two months to the day after King was killed. The man escaped with about 100 pounds—\$240—in five-pound notes.

When Ray was arrested four days later he had 60 pounds in five-pound notes. He also had just bought a ticket to Brussels.

A description of the robber given police by the bank manager matches Ray.

The evidence was turned up as Scotland Yard prepared a dossier in an attempt to track down any hint in London of conspiracy in King's assassination.

British detection said they could find nothing to indicate Ray had any association with possible confederates, political ontacts or anyone disc
