

Request for Review of Files (U)



- 2. (U/AIUO) <u>Background</u>: Reference is made to the attached House Select <u>Committee</u> on Assassinations (HSCA) requests dated 8 and 14 February 1978 (OLC 78-0674/1 and OLC 78-0588/1). The HSCA has requested access to all files and index references regarding some 47 individuals and organizations. Additionally, the Select Committee has requested access to a number of Agency documents, identified in the 14 February request.
- (S) Regarding the 8 February request, the Office of Security has material available for review on the National States Rights Party (#1), Jessie B. Stoner (#2), Edward Fields (#3), the National Democratic Party of West Germany (#8), and the Southern Christian Leadership Conference (#17). Third agency material only was located for Robert DePugh (#4) and the Front Nationale (#7). Overt source material only was found pertaining to Jerry William and John Larry Ray (#15 and #16). Without additional identifying information, a meaningful search cannot be conducted regarding George Wright (#6) or H. Hunt (#22). This Office has no record of #5 (National Front or Liberty Party), #8 (Hitler Welle), #9 (VMO; Flemich VMO), #10-#14, and #19-#21. A search of James Earl Ray's aliases (#18) disclosed references to his subject file which was made previously available for review pursuant to the HSCA's request of 19 January 1978.
- (S) Regarding the 14 February request, this Office has material available for review regarding Louis Kutner (#12). No record was located for item numbers 1-11, #12 (Louis Cutner), #13 (Harry Haller; Harry Helfgett), and

It should be noted, however, that an absence of sufficient identifying information on the majority of the foregoing makes an identification practically impossible. This is particularly true in the case of #13 (Harvey Hall, aka Harry Sinclair, Jr., and Ed Pawley, Jr.). A number of files were located on different individuals with the same name as Hall, Sinclair, or Pawley.

(U/AIUO) Of the 7 items, on the 14 February request, identifying documents the HSCA is interested in, this Office was advised by the Office of Legislative Counsel that only #2 (letter dated 18 November 1963) involves an Office of Security response. Unfortunately, we have been unable to locate this item because of a lack of identifying information. It is requested that your Office contact the Federal Bureau of Investigation and ascertain the subject of the above letter.
