MEMORANDUM:

SUBJECT: Arrival of James Rufus FORMAN in Paris from STOCKHOLM

According to a bulletin issued by Prensa Latina in Paris and dated 19 April 1968, Subject arrived in Paris from Stockholm on 18 April. He was scheduled to give a press conference on 22 April to speak on the "Liberation of Negroes in the United States." He was ✓ to cite the cases of Martin Luther King, Bobby Hutton (Deceased ✓ treasurer of the Black Panthers), Huey Newton, and Eldridge Cleaver. Subject is scheduled to speak again on 29 April at the Mutualite Hall ✓ in Paris. Aime CESAIRE and Jean Paul SARTRE are scheduled to attend this meeting.

According to other information available to this office, Pedro MACHADO, Prensa Latina representative in Paris, who is a known Cuban Intelligence officer, expects to interview FORMAN during his stay in Paris.
