THESE WILL INCLUDE BRADFORD LITTLE, OF THE COMMITTEE FOR NONVIOLENT ACTION; RENNIE DAVIS; RICHARD FERNANDEZ, THE LEADER OF CLERGY AND LAYMEN CONCERNED ABOUT VIETNAM; AN SCLC REPRESENTATIVE; AND A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE NATIONAL WELFARE RIGHTS ORGANIZATION.

IT WAS ALSO DECIDED TO CHANGE THE NAME OF THE NCAWRR TO THE "PEOPLE'S COALITION FOR PEACE AND JUSTICE." THE NEXT MEETING OF THE CONTINUATIONS COMMITTEE WILL BE HELD AT WASHINGTON, D.C., FEBRUARY TWENTY SEVEN - TWENTY EIGHT NEXT.
